

CA Hard-To-Count (HTC) Index: Population Estimates for San Diego County

Note: This analysis sums all persons living in tracts whose [CA-HTC](#) score was equal to or exceeded 57 (column B) and discrete hard-to-count populations living outside those tracts (column C) to produce a comprehensive countywide total. Discrete hard-to-count populations include Latino/Hispanic noncitizens, Non-Hispanic Whites living below the poverty line, Asian Americans with limited English proficiency, Blacks/African Americans living below the poverty line, American Indians/Alaskan Natives, and Pacific Islanders. Missing tract-level data capturing discrete hard-to-count populations were estimated using tract-level population counts and county-level social, economic characteristic data. The details of columns two and four do not sum to the total because some people are included in more than one group if they selected more than one racial group and/or selected Hispanic. Individuals are included in more than one group in an effort to be inclusive and follow recommendations from the U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB).
